

WHAT REALLY HAPPENED IN ITALY?

The purpose of this paper is to revisit the details surrounding the COVID situation in Italy, in early 2020. As you will recall, it was first Wuhan and then Italy that caused the initial COVID scare, and it was Italy that allegedly had the highest rates of initial illnesses and deaths, essentially kicking off the worldwide COVID pandemic hoax. All eyes were on Italy early, so let's take a trip down memory lane and recount the events of what **really** happened.



The red highlighted region is the northern region of [Lombardy](#), Italy. It is where the vast majority of initial COVID cases (or the “outbreak”) happened.

First, let’s look at some basic facts.

- Italy’s population is approximately 60 million ([Source](#))
- Lombardy’s population is approximately 10 million ([Source](#))
- Lombardy’s elderly population is approximately 21.6% of the total Lombardy population, a value in line with the Italian average and higher than the EU28 share, which is 18.9% ([Source](#))
- Italy ranks 9th in the world for Largest Percentage of Elderly ([Source](#))

As of March 21, 2020 we were told that there were 2549 COVID-19 victims in the northern region of [Lombardy](#) out of a total of 3405 Italian victims. This means that ~75% of all Italian COVID-19 deaths at that time were concentrated in the Lombardy region, which hosts a total of 16% of the Italian population.

We were also told that there were a total of 10,031 total Global deaths from COVID-19 at that time. This means that the death toll in Lombardy (2549) accounted for **25.4% of the entire GLOBAL death toll (at that time)**.

However, 7 days earlier, on March 14, 2020 the President of the [ISS](#) (Italy's highest ranking medical authority) stated in an official press conference that only 2 people had (perhaps) died from the COVID-19 virus, although he also clarified that those 2 deaths were still unconfirmed as being caused by COVID-19.

On March 18 (4 days later), the ISS reported that [12 people had died in Italy](#) without previous pathologies, after having contracted coronavirus.

*"Rome, 13 Mar 19:12 - (Agenzia Nova) - The people who died of coronavirus in Italy, who did not have other diseases, **could be only two**. This is what emerges from the medical records examined so far by the Higher Institute of Health, according to the President of the Institute, Silvio Brusaferro, during the press conference held today at the Civil Protection in Rome. "The positive deceased patients have an average age of over 80 years - 80.3 to be exact - and are predominantly male," said Brusaferro. "Women make up 25.8%. The average age of the deceased is significantly higher than the other positives. The age groups over 70, with a peak between 80 and 89 years. The majority of these people are carriers of chronic diseases. Only two people have not been found to be carriers of pathologies at the moment", but even in these two cases, the examination of the records is not concluded and therefore causes of death other than Covid-19 may emerge. The president of the Iss has specified that so far "just over one hundred medical records" have been received from hospitals throughout Italy."*

In other words, only 2 persons were believed to have been killed by the Coronavirus in Italy - but there was still no confirmation that Covid-19 was the cause of death.

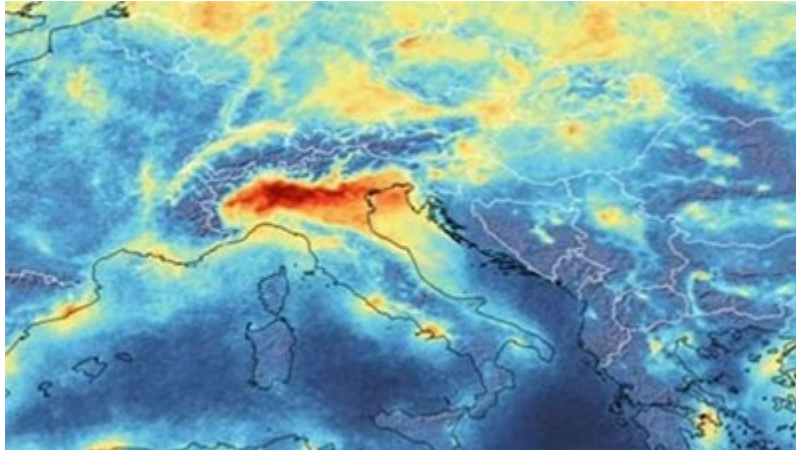
Meanwhile, official data released by the WHO at this time said that there were over 3,000 deaths due to COVID-19 in Italy.

So, why did this happen and why such a huge discrepancy between what the official statistics said and what the President of the ISS said? Well part of the reason is that the vast majority of so-called COVID cases were actually elderly people with comorbidities. We'll come back to that later, but first we should ask – what made Lombardy so unique and why was it here that COVID allegedly

exploded?

Let's take a look at some valuable information and start a very simple and basic investigation.

The first thing to note is that the air quality in this region is among the worst in all of Europe. The following image is from Germany's wetteronline.de



*The Lombardy region in [northern Italy](#) ranks among the most air polluted areas of Europe.^[88] Because of high [industrialization](#) and the **lack of wind** due to being closed between mountain ranges **air pollution remains a severe problem in Lombardy** and northern Italy...The data show that many cities in Lombardy and the Po Valley suffer the **most serious impact at European level due to poor air quality, first of all the metropolitan area of Milan**, thirteenth in the ranking in terms of fine particulate impact, where any year **3967 premature deaths** – approximately 9% of the total.. ([Source](#))*

In the previous few years (prior to the COVID outbreak), there had been an inexplicable rise in influenza and pneumonia cases in Lombardy. See [this example](#) from 2018, and [this example](#) from 2019.

On February 25, 2020 [this article](#) was posted in one of Italy's largest newspapers, *La Repubblica*.

Estimated cases of "sindrome simil-influenzale" in Italy between October 14, 2019 and mid-February 2020: 5,632,000. That is almost 10% of Italy's entire

population that was sick with influenza between October, 2019 and February, 2020. Of course, most of these people wouldn't normally go to the hospital, because it's just the flu, right? A large portion would probably just stay home and sweat it out, like we all do, when we have the flu.

However, shortly afterwards (beginning in March), things began to change. As the number of "coronavirus" cases increased in Italy, the [number of influenza cases decreased](#). I'm sure you can figure out why that happened.

So now, all of these people who had normal flu-like symptoms naturally began rushing to the hospital, as soon as it was **psychologically suggested to them**, that they might be infected with a deadly novel virus. The psychological suggestion created the panic which helped to create the *illusion* that thousands of people have suddenly been infected. The "overrun hospitals" helped to further this illusion. But we can confirm that over 5 million Italians (10% of the entire population) had the flu, just before this all started in March. As we can clearly see, all of these influenza patients were simply *reclassified* as COVID patients.

It is still odd that so many people were sick with influenza, so why did this happen? Well, perhaps the air quality had something to do with it, but maybe there was something else...

On March 26, Professor Remuzzi who is the Director of the Mario Negri Institute for Pharmacological Research in Milan said in an interview that "local doctors remember having seen **very strange pneumonias [sic], very severe, particularly in old people, in December and even in November.**"

...

He said: "These are rumors of a small number of people and impressions of a few doctors who however did not confirm to me that they had seen bilateral pneumonia before January." ([Source](#))

Remuzzi of course attributes this to an invisible virus that came from Wuhan, but we know that's a lie, so what really caused these abnormal illnesses of pneumonia and influenza in the fall of 2019, into the winter of 2020?

Well, it turns out that many elderly Lombards who were vaccinated in November 2019 began getting sick **within a few days**, as the region began to report very

severe, strange pneumonia appearing in people.

In Bergamo (a town in Lombardy), 185,000 doses of the influenza vaccine were ordered on October 21, 2019. ([Source](#))

*The 2019-2020 anti-flu and pneumococcal campaign organized by the Health Protection Agency and by the ASST of the province of Bergamo in collaboration with the Family Doctors will start on **4 November**.*

...

"... 185,000 doses of vaccine have been ordered this year....The flu vaccination is offered free of charge to the following risk categories:

- *Persons aged 65 or over (born in 1954 and earlier)...*
- *chronic diseases affecting the respiratory system; diseases of the cardiovascular system; diabetes mellitus and other metabolic diseases; tumors; chronic liver diseases; kidney disease with chronic kidney failure;*



Remember that the so-called “pandemic” in Italy began mostly in the northern region of **Lombardy**. As it turns out (in addition to the Bergamo vaccines above), between December 24, 2019 and January 18, 2020, Lombardy also had a **free vaccination program for meningitis**. That’s right, over 34,000 people were given the meningitis vaccine for free. It’s also worth noting that Italy had been engaged in a mass meningitis fear

campaign for a few years which had been highly controversial. All of the small towns where the vaccines were administered were located generally in the same area where the 11 small towns of the first cases of Coronavirus were reported, in **Lombardy**.

Normies will say that correlation doesn't equal causation, and that's fair. But shouldn't we apply the same logic to an invisible virus that nobody has properly isolated? Wouldn't the vaccine be a more logical place to start our investigation as to what really caused these illnesses?

Well there's another important fact that most people don't know, which is that between December 2019 and January 2020, **1.2 million influenza vaccines of a new type were also administered in the Lombardy region.** ([Source](#) and [Source](#))

*"The **widespread distribution of vaccines** through pharmacies and the good adherence of general practitioners are reaping good fruits. The **influenza [vaccine] campaign** launched by the ATS is in fact already recording **record numbers**, and is not yet completed. With this new model we have dispensed **1,183,660 vaccines in the entire Lombardy Region.**"*

This **experimental** vaccine was presented by the ISS as a "brand new quadrivalent vaccine" and was injected into the bodies of 1.2 million Lombards (most of them elderly). This was an unprecedented amount of vaccines in all of the area's history. Additionally, for the first time in Italy's history, these vaccines were distributed to not only hospitals but also to general practitioners and pharmacies.

Within a few short months, elderly people suddenly began to get sick and die in Lombardy and adjacent regions where all of the initial so-called COVID deaths were reported. On top of all of this, there were **NO AUTOPSIES ALLOWED BY THE ISS** in the early stages of the pandemic.

When a few brave Italian doctors began to perform some autopsies they discovered **thrombosis/blood clots** in the patients, most likely caused by the vaccines. Ventilators also likely accelerated their demise. Americans will remember a similar story that took place in New York.

Logical people might conclude that there could be a causation or correlation here, and demand further investigation. Insane people choose to believe fairy tales about invisible viruses and other silly superstitions, not rooted in reality.

Matteo Gracis is an independent Italian journalist who had been closely following the "pandemic" in Italy since day one. He consistently reported on the countless, outrageous absurdities that were found in the various officially released statistics related to the "COVID-19 pandemic."

One of the many absurdities that he pointed out is what the President of ISTAT (the governmental institute that monitors Italy's demographic / mortality data) said on April 2, 2020:

*In March 2019 the deaths from various pneumonia [in Italy] were 15 thousand, and therefore **more people died from respiratory diseases than this year from Coronavirus**. ISTAT's president, Gian Carlo Blangiardo, explains this in an interview with 'Avvenire'.*

Matteo rightly asked: "WHY IS THE ENTIRE NATION OF ITALY LOCKED DOWN - ON THE BASIS OF THOSE NUMBERS WHICH DO NOT WARRANT ANY EMERGENCY MEASURES AT ALL?" ([Source](#))

Here are some more interesting and largely unknown facts and one more thing to consider.

- *The community of Chinese people in Italy has grown rapidly in the past ten years. Official statistics indicate there are at least 320,794 Chinese citizens in Italy. Milan, in Northern Italy where COVID-19 first struck, has the largest Chinese population in Italy.*
- *On January 22nd, 2020, Customs authorities from the Guardia di Finanza in the northern Italian city of Padua seized and burnt nearly 10 tons of Chinese pig meat, potentially infected with African swine fever. By the end of 2019, half of China's swine herd — **250 million pigs, were dead**. Padua is located in the Veneto region of Italy. The coronavirus, AKA Covid-19, first appeared in Lombardy (Milan) and Veneto (Padua). Swine fever is deadly among pigs, though it poses no risk to humans.*
- *But if Italy thought it had incinerated its problems away by **burning tainted Chinese pig meat**, much of which probably originated from Wuhan's vast pig reservoir, it had another thought coming. Now, infectious particles were circulating through the air of Northern Italy. Furthermore, if Swine fever posed no risk to humans, what did pose a risk is a common disease in pigs called *Mycobacterium avium* (AKA MAC or fowl tuberculosis), a non-tubercular mycobacteria (NTM). In*

one study, the incidence of *Mycobacterium avium* (fowl tuberculosis) in a pig population was an astonishing 81%. As reported by some workers, ***M. avium* isolates from swine represent a major threat to human beings.** And the similarity of the IS1245 RFLP [restriction fragment length polymorphism (RFLP)] **patterns of the human and porcine isolates indicated a close genetic relatedness, suggesting that *M. avium* is transmitted between pigs and humans.** Such *M. avium* infection can occur wherever the right “underlying pulmonary conditions” exist, which can be an event as simple as a childhood or reactivated tubercular infection, or merely tying up the lungs with an excess of dust or particulate matter. I don't necessarily agree with all of the conclusions above, but I thought it was interesting enough to include, simply for the fact that burning tainted pig meat could be an additional contributing factor to poor air quality in an already highly polluted area which could potentially lead to more respiratory illnesses.

The following however you shall not eat...and the swine-although it has true hoofs: with the hoofs cleft through, it does not chew the cud: it is unclean for you. You shall not eat of their flesh or touch their carcasses; they are unclean for you.” -Leviticus 11: 4-8

So what have we learned? What really happened in Italy?

The explanation is simple. The vast majority of so-called COVID cases and deaths were *most likely* a result of a combination of the following:

- 1) Fraudulent statistics based on reclassifying multiple illnesses such as respiratory illness, pneumonia, influenza, etc. to “COVID.”
- 2) An increase in these illnesses over normal numbers as a direct result of multiple mass vaccination campaigns in Lombardy.
- 3) Pollution and subsequent poor air quality contributed to illness.

It's that simple. Elderly people died, probably in higher numbers than previous years, because of the vaccines and poor air quality. These elderly people die every year from a variety of different illnesses, many of them respiratory related. Many Lombards (most of them elderly) presented with flu-like symptoms, and were diagnosed with COVID-19 based on nothing but a fraudulent PCR test.

[Bloomberg](#) and [other media](#) outlets confirmed that **99%** of Italians who died “from

COVID” had other pre-existing illnesses and half of the deaths were in people who had 3 existing illnesses. The average age of victims was 79.5 years old, and the only deaths among people under 40 were in males with serious existing medical conditions. Additionally, the areas with the highest death rates also have high air pollution.

COVID didn't exist in Italy, at least not in the way it was defined, specifically the part about it being caused by a virus called SARS-COV-2.

COVID in Italy is the same as it is everywhere else. It's an expression of flu-like symptoms which is a part of the body's normal detox process.

Any elevated statistics were a direct result of **toxic vaccines**, administered to vulnerable elderly people, with multiple comorbidities. Most of them would have died from their comorbidities anyways, but the vaccines were the final nail in their coffin or the straw that broke the camel's back.
